**PURPOSE:**

To establish guidelines for subsidy arrangements in temporary care or Child and Family Services arrangements for children.

**POLICY:**

In the case of temporary arrangements with a person with no legal responsibility for a child, the child care subsidy will continue to be based on the custodial parents' income.

**PROCEDURE:**

1. If a grandparent, other family member or a friend has agreed to accept temporary care of a child, whom otherwise would be placed in the care of Child and Family Services, subsidy arrangements will continue based on the custodial parents' income and assets. An exception will be made in the case where extended arrangements must occur due to an inability to locate the custodial parent.
2. If a child is placed in the care of the Child and Family Services, the financial responsibility for child care will reside with that agency.
