**1. POLICY STATEMENT**

Ambulance staff are to obey all rules or directions given by air/ground crew for meeting helicopters and fixed wing aircraft when picking up or delivering a patient from a designated aircraft.

**2. PROCEDURE**

- 2.1 Dispatch is to ascertain and advise ambulance staff how, where, and who to contact to gain access to an airport.
- 2.2 Ambulance staff are to follow instructions/directions pertaining to safety rules/procedures given by air/ground crew/security personnel that are assigned to them during the period on airport site.
- 2.3 The aircraft crew and flight paramedics are responsible for patient care and loading the patient onto the aircraft once the transfer of care has occurred between the paramedic crews.
